The children will need to have an adult responsible for transporting and accompanying them to the event. The facility is located about 6 miles from UMES at 12469 Lee Jackson Memorial Highway, Fairfax. (703) 383-0060.

Union Mill Rd. to a right on Lee Hwy/US-29N. Turn left onto Stringfellow Rd/VA-645N. Follow past Chantilly high school to a right onto Lee Jackson Memorial Hwy/ US-50E. Once you cross under Fairfax County Parkway, the next stop light is Dorforth Rd. You will use a right turn onto Dorforth to U-turn on Rt. 50. So make the right on Dorforth and just keep turning until you're riding parallel to Rt. 50. Turn left at the *Manor Care* sign. Follow the road past Manor Care until you see the *Arden Court* sign.

It is a locked facility so we'll just meet in the parking lot at the main entrance a little before 2pm. If you arrive late, please ring the doorbell and a receptionist will be happy to let you in.
